Sustainability

- Imoves dance package has provided staff with teaching skills and resources to teach dance now and in the future.
- Central Soccer - Mr Smith has provided Key Stage 1 and Key Stage 2 pupils with opportunities to experience a range of football activities and has enabled them to compete in inter-house competitions and extra-curricular competitions.
- Reception External Play Area - funding has provided over 60 pupils with a range of activities to develop their motor skills. These activity stations should now last between 5 and 10 years.

Training

- Level 5 Coaching - Miss Round is undertaking a Level 5 coaching course. This will enable her to deliver and support PE across the school. Years 2 and 6 have benefitted already from her expertise in football and gymnastics leading to increased pupil participation both in and out of school.
- Cheerleading - Mrs Snowden has undertaken a cheerleading course and is now planning to run a club. She has already involved our Forces pupils in this activity which has been a great success.
- Courses - Miss Round and Mrs Smith have attended various courses to support the PE Action Plan and health and safety issues in PE.

Resources

- PE equipment has been purchased/replaced, e.g. bats, balls, hoops, bean bags, etc.; to ensure that all year groups have access to the appropriate equipment in PE lessons.
- Playtime equipment has been purchased to provide pupils with opportunities to engage in physical activities outside of PE lessons.
