Behaviour records to be monitored.
3) To improve attendance and punctuality of pupil premium students.	Sport breakfast club to be held every Monday morning free of charge to all FSM and Ever6 pupils. Enrichment activities - artist involvement, before and after school clubs etc.	£4000	Attendance to both the club and school. Children's punctuality to be monitored.
4) To support the families and community of all pupil premium students.	Offering parental support, links with the military, EAL support.	£30 000	Pupil voice Parent forum Attendance and behaviour records
