Feedback from Parent Forum

Charity events and contributions

- Parents didn't feel that there were too many contributions requested and were happy to give to charities to show children how to help others
- Ensure that charity events were spread over the year as they have been this year
- If there were three or more children in the family, a group contribution is acceptable

Summer/Christmas Fair

- Parents agreed that it would be nice for school to organise a summer/Christmas fair

Lunchtime provision

- We have now ensured that children's lunchboxes are checked by the lunchtime supervisors before the child leaves the hall and all uneaten food is kept in the lunch boxes so parents know what has been eaten. Since our last forum, parents reported that this doesn't seem to be a problem.

Behaviour policy

- We are currently reviewing our behaviour policy and have discontinued golden time as it was ineffective. We have trialled using cubes to celebrate good behaviour of the class.
- Parents stated that their children had a positive response to the cubes, however it may be a good idea to offer a choice of activities as a reward.
- Top Team Treat continues to have a good impact. Principal's tea party was still a positive reward.

Mental health

- A parent emailed what we do to support children's mental health. We discussed what we do and will put this on a newsletter to inform all parents of the actions and strategies we use.
