Four members of the public spoke to staff stating how well behaved our children were. Thank you to all staff who gave up their Friday evening to take them.

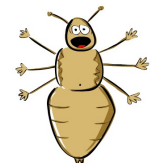


## Conduct at school

## Attendance

We have had several requests for additional leave from school in school term time. The Education Regulations 2006 make it clear that Principals should only grant a leave of absence during term time if there are exceptional circumstances to justify this. Any unauthorised leave of more than one day must be reported to Staffordshire County Council Attendance and it is there that the decision is made whether to enforce a penalty. This decision is not made by the school; the school are not given details on whether a penalty has been issued nor do the school receive any of the penalty fine.
